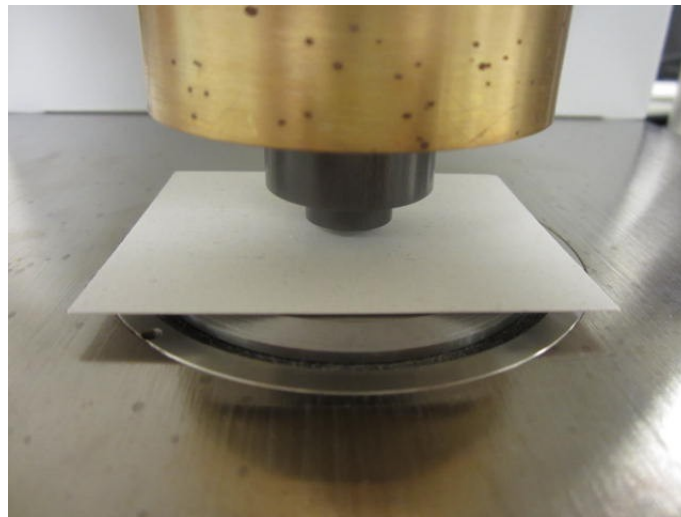
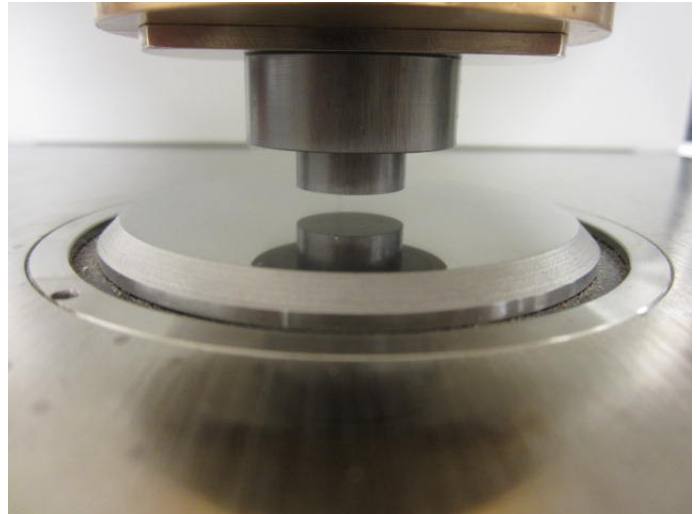


Caliper

Caliper is the thickness of a paper or board. Caliper is expressed as points or mils in the English system, with one point of caliper representing 0.001 inch in thickness. In the metric system, caliper is expressed in microns. Unless otherwise stated, TAPPI Test Method T411 is the standard procedure used for measuring caliper. This method measures the thickness of the sample under a test pressure of 50 kPa (7.3 psi). The caliper of corrugated board is also measured using TAPPI Test Method T411 to measure the thickness of the combined product.
